Hyliko at IAA Transportation 2024: International expansion for the French leader in "Hydrogen & Trucks as a Service"

Hannover, September 16th 2024

Hyliko, the French startup specializing in decarbonizing road freight transport through green hydrogen, makes a significant international debut at IAA Transportation 2024, the world's leading logistics and transport platform. This trade show—held from September 17 to 22 in Hannover—marks Hyliko's first opportunity to present its pioneering zero-emission mobility solution on an international stage, offering trucks, energy, and services. It represents a major milestone in the company's European expansion, following key successes in its home market.

Green hydrogen road transport: a concrete reality in France thanks to Hyliko

The year 2024 has been marked by significant milestones for Hyliko:

- Approval of the first range of hydrogen retrofit vehicles in France: This fleet, which includes vehicles ranging from 26-ton carriers to 44-ton tractors, meets a wide range of freight transport needs.
- Deployment of the first hydrogen vehicles in France: In collaboration with partners such as Point P, Berto, and Labatut for retrofitted vehicles, as well as Bert&You for both new and retrofitted trucks, Hyliko now has nearly five hydrogen trucks in circulation, forming the largest hydrogen truck ecosystem in France.
- Opening of France's first hydrogen hub dedicated to heavy goods vehicles: Located 30 km south of Paris, the Hyliko Paris-Sud site in Villabé (91) includes a 350-bar green hydrogen refueling station and a service center for hydrogen truck maintenance, staffed by experts in this emerging technology.
- Extension of Hyliko's truck offering in partnership with Hyundai: This includes the Xcient Fuel Cell model, which is particularly well-suited for temperature-controlled transport.

French leader in Hydrogen Transport set to conquer new international markets

Hyliko offers a turnkey solution for freight carriers looking to decarbonize their fleet, including hydrogen truck rentals (new or retrofitted), access to a green hydrogen network, and comprehensive fleet management services. Through its participation in IAA Transportation 2024, Hyliko reaffirms its ambition to become a key player in

decarbonizing road transport across Europe. Building on its success in France, the company is now ready to bring its unique expertise to international markets. Initial discussions with foreign partners indicate strong interest in joining this exciting venture. For the first time, Hyliko will showcase its 44-ton hydrogen retrofit tractor at the Test&Drive, allowing decision-makers to experience this new technology developed by Hyliko Trucks.

Hyliko CEO Ovarith Troeung explains: "With the launch of our first hydrogen trucks this summer, we've made hydrogen a daily reality for carriers and contractors committed to decarbonizing their transport operations. Our hydrogen ecosystem approach—integrating all the necessary infrastructure and services for hydrogen trucks at key nodes such as the Hyliko Paris-Sud Excellence Center—has successfully supported this deployment. The expansion of our hydrogen network, either independently or through partnerships, is already focusing on strategic regions connected by major roadways. Extending to European corridors is a top priority, with upcoming announcements that will make our solution viable on a continental scale. We are ready to replicate our model wherever there is a shared commitment to sustainable transport."
